Program and Volunteer Position Descriptions

Bible Club

Bible Club is City Impact's core faith program for children, preschool through 5th grade. It is a relationally-based, volunteer-driven program offered year-round that combines Biblical teaching, service to others, and leadership development to engage and empower youth to live out their faith and make a positive impact in their community. Bible Club meets every Tuesday from 6:00pm-8:15pm at First Baptist Church located at 1340 K Street.

Serve weekly as a:

- Small Group Leader for an age group of your choice (preschool-5th grade), cooperatively assisting the Classroom Leader by managing and caring for an assigned group of 2-8 youth.

Impact Leadership Academy

ILA is City Impact's core faith program for students, grades 6-12. It is a relationally-based, volunteer driven program offered year-round that uses an interactive, talent-building, curriculum to teach scripture, personal responsibility, and servant-leadership. ILA guides teens to use their God-given talents in writing, public speaking, philanthropy and social justice to improve the community. ILA meets every Sunday night from 6pm-9pm at First Baptist Church located at 1340 K Street.

Serve weekly as a:

- Small Group Leader for the middle school boys room, cooperatively assisting the Classroom Leader by managing and caring for an assigned group of 2-8 youth. Sundays from 6:00pm-7:45pm.
- Youth Leadership Team Helper for the Philanthropy or Writing Team. Assisting middle and high school students with youth leadership projects. Sundays from 8pm-9pm.

Strengths for Life Mentoring

Strengths for Life mentoring is a faith-based, strengths-based, once-a-month, mentoring program that matches adults with City Impact students, grades 3-12. This program focuses on our students' God-given gifts and talents by giving opportunities to participate in interest activities and college and career exploration and preparation.

Serve monthly as a/n:

- Interest Mentor: Mentor a student (grades 3-12) in a similar interest activity such as a sport, instrument, or other hobby.
- Career Mentor: Mentor a student (grades 3-8) in career exploration. Participate in a minimum of 6 site visits with your student to different businesses that have agreed to participate in our program. Use remaining visits for fun activities in the community.
- College Mentor: Mentor a student (grades 9-12) through the process of exploring, preparing for, and applying to colleges.
